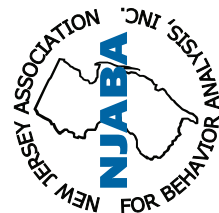

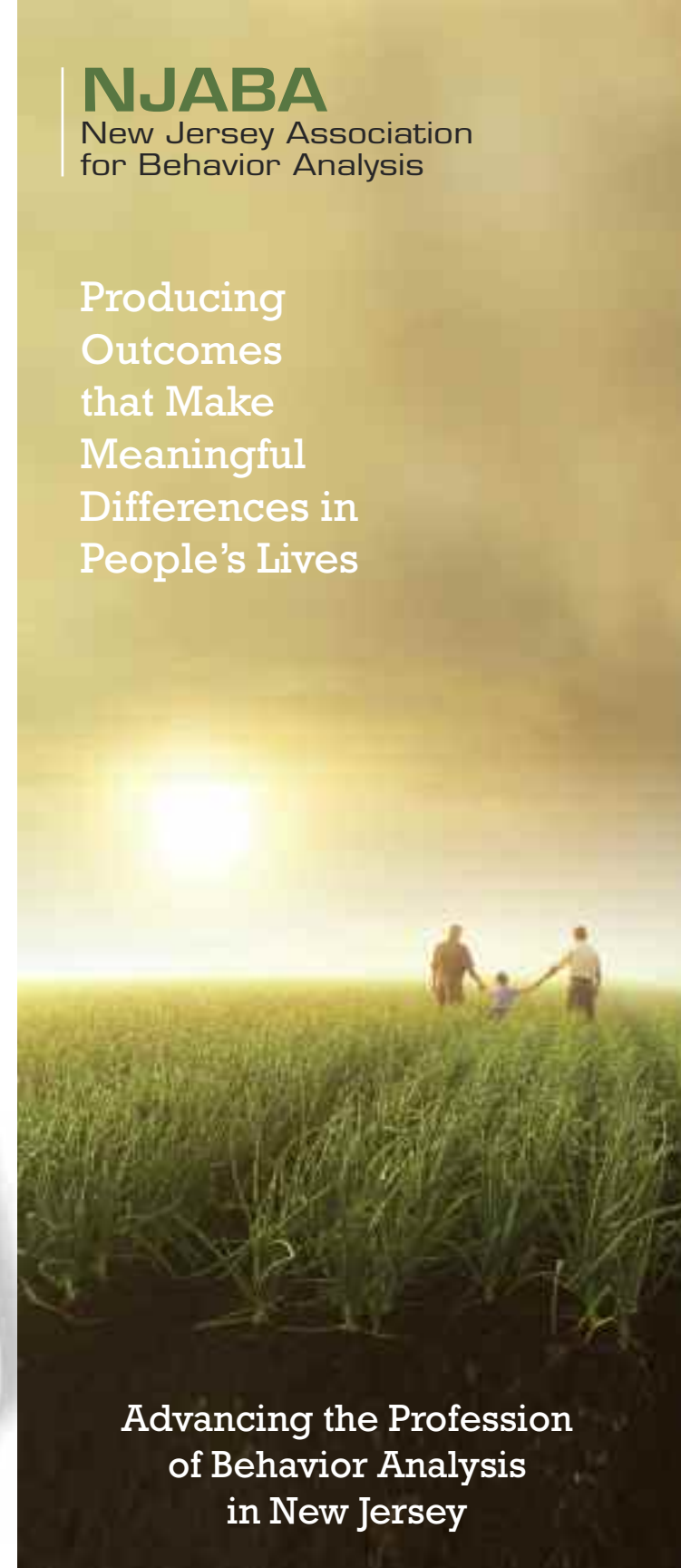

Definition of Applied Behavior Analysis



Applied behavior analysis was first defined in 1968 by Baer, Wolf, and Risley in their classic paper, "Some Current Dimensions of Applied Behavior Analysis." They observed that the science and practice of applied behavior analysis is characterized by seven dimensions:

- **Applied:** addresses the concerns that individuals bring to the researcher or practitioner
- **Behavioral:** focuses on observable behavior
- **Analytic:** seeks to identify the functional relationships between environment and behavior
- **Conceptually systematic:** is based on known principles of behavior (e.g., reinforcement)
- **Technological:** utilizes written procedures
- **Generality:** emphasizes outcomes that have value beyond the research or practice setting
- **Effective:** solves the problems of the consumer

Still true today, behavior analysts skillfully combine these dimensions to produce individualized and effective solutions.
